

Fake Amazon emails 'exclusive rewards'

Bromley Trading Standards is supporting Action Fraud to highlight fake emails purporting to be from Amazon.

Action Fraud has received over 220 reports this week about the fake emails. The emails claim to offer an “exclusive reward” if the recipient completes an online survey within an hour. The links lead to genuine-looking phishing websites that are designed to steal Amazon login in credentials, as well as personal and financial information.

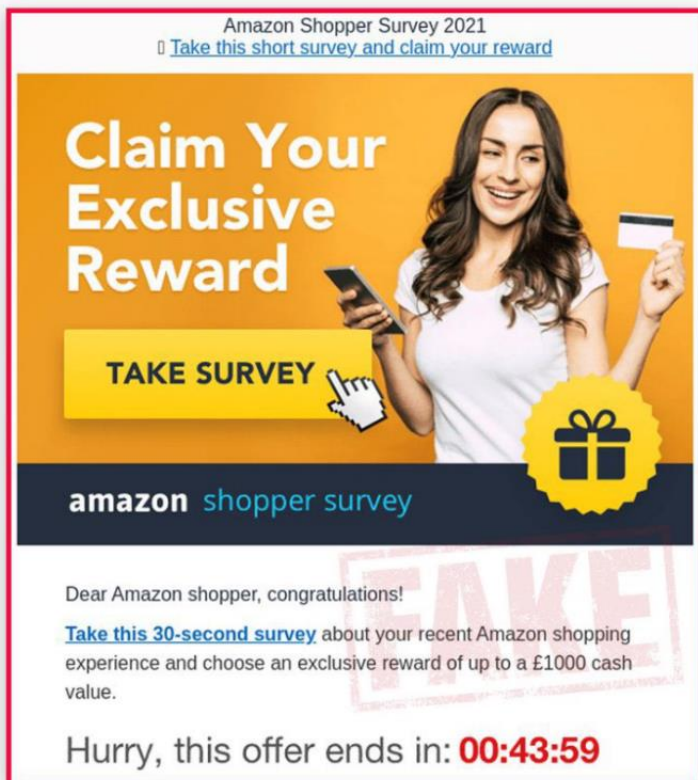


Your bank, or any other organisation, won't ask you to share personal information over email or text. If you need to check that it's a genuine message, contact them directly.

Suspicious emails – if you have spotted a suspicious email, forward it to the Suspicious Email Reporting Service (SERS) – report@phishing.gov.uk

Suspicious texts – if you've received a suspicious text message, forward it to your service provider on **7726**

Never click on links or attachments in emails or text messages that you are not expecting.
